UPHOLSTERY CARE GUIDE

COMMONLY USED CARE CODES

Cleaning Code W: Instruct a professional cleaning service to use foam from a water-based cleansing agent.

Code SW: Instruct a professional cleaning service to use water-based cleansing agents, foam or pure solvents.

Cleaning Code S: Instruct a professional cleaning service to use pure, water-free solvents. Petroleum distillate-based products may be used.

Code X: These fabrics can only be cleaned by vacuuming or light brushing.

CARE AND CLEANING TIPS

As a general rule, spot cleaning is not recommended, as it can cause fading. It's best to professionally clean the entire piece to ensure the color remains uniform.

We recommend vacuuming frequently to remove dust, always using the brush attachment to prevent fabric damage.

Protect from heat and liquids. If spills occur, blot immediately with a clean, dry cloth.

Rotate cushions periodically.

To keep your upholstery in optimal condition, avoid direct sunlight.

Our manufacturers do not use any flame retardants; we believe the best products are as free of chemicals as possible.

OUR CUSTOM UPHOLSTERIES

LINEN

Soft linen and viscose upholstery is fine-woven with a slubbed, cross-hatched texture.

Suitable for light to medium domestic use.

55% Linen, 45% Viscose

PROFESSIONALLY CLEAN

Cleaning Code S (Solvent Only)

Clean with a mild, water-free, dry-cleaning solvent. Ensure ample ventilation.

BASKETWEAVE LINEN

Textured basketweave linen and polyester upholstery expertly retains its shape and resists wear.

May feel stiff at first, but relaxes beautifully with use and time

Suitable for extra heavy-duty domestic or high-traffic commercial use.

90% Polyester, 10% Linen

PROFESSIONALLY CLEAN

Cleaning Code S (Solvent Only)

Clean with a mild, water-free, dry-cleaning solvent. Ensure ample ventilation.

BELGIAN LINEN

Lightly textural Belgian linen upholstery is the product of Libeco, a 150-year-old, CO₂-neutral mill that uses every part or organically grown flax to create fine, hypo-allergenic linen that becomes stronger and softer with time.

Suitable for heavy-duty domestic or low-traffic commercial use.

Cleaning Code SW (Solvent & Water)

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Spot clean with mild soap and cold water. We recommend testing all cleansers in an inconspicuous area before you treat your furniture.

VELVET

Cotton velvet upholstery has a durable, soft pile and rich, saturated color. Marking or pressure marks after sitting are normal and will generally recover with time and natural humidity. Some slight bruises or marks may never fully disappear; this should be considered an enhancement to your furniture.

Suitable for heavy-duty commercial use.

74% Cotton, 26% Polyester (100% Cotton Pile)

PROFESSIONALLY CLEAN

Cleaning Code S (Solvent Only)

Clean with a mild, water-free, dry-cleaning solvent. Ensure ample ventilation.

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Occasional vacuuming is recommended. Most stains can be blotted or wiped away with a clean, damp cloth or paper towel; dried stains can be spot cleaned using soap and water or a commercial dry cleaning product. We recommend testing all cleansers in an inconspicuous area before treating your furniture. Once dry, use a soft, dry brush in the direction of the pile to restore the loft and uniformity of the fabric.

SLUB VELVET

Slubbed cotton and rayon upholstery has a lustrous, low pile with a vintage-inspired sheen. Marking or pressure marks after sitting are normal and will generally recover with time and natural humidity. Some slight bruises or marks may never fully disappear; this should be considered an enhancement to your furniture.

Suitable for heavy-duty commercial use.

41% Cotton, 50% Rayon, 9% Polyester (100% Rayon Pile)

PROFESSIONALLY CLEAN

Cleaning Code S (Solvent Only)

Clean with a mild, water-free, dry-cleaning solvent. Ensure ample ventilation.

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Brush or vacuum loose dirt from the surface of the fabric, following the natural direction of the nap.

Please note that while the fabric finish resists immediate absorption, spills should be addressed as quickly as possible. Water stains may become permanent and unable to be removed with solvent cleaning agents.

Our slub velvet is a uniquely constructed and finished fabric developed to emulate the look of antique silk velvet. Because the rayon pile is highly sensitive to moisture, it can incur permanent damage when exposed to excessive humidity, dampness or heavy pressure. Blot or wiper spills immediately with a dry paper towel.

Stains should be addressed with professional dry cleaning.

LEATHER

Durable, top-grain leather upholstery has a slightly matte, hand-rubbed finish that remains uniform and consistent over time.

Ideal for families and high-traffic areas.

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Clean with a cloth dampened with distilled or purified water; dry with a clean, soft cloth. Blot spills and allow to air dry. Do not use leather soaps, oils or abrasive cleansers.

PREMIUM LEATHER

Full-grain leather upholstery is soft, durable and gradually develops a natural, heirloom-in-the-making patina over time.

It has not been sanded or buffed to remove imperfections and therefore shows more of the characteristics of the hide.

Color is achieved through an aniline dyeing process, wherein soluble dyes are absorbed into the hide without masking or covering its natural traits.

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Conditioners and cleansers specifically recommended for natural leather may be used. We recommend testing all products in an inconspicuous area before treating your furniture.

BRUSHED COTTON

Woven cotton upholstery is soft and smooth, with a matte texture and a slightly heathered effect.

Suitable for general domestic use.

100% Cotton

Cleaning Code SW (Solvent & Water)

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Vacuum regularly; use a soft brush to loosen and remove surface dirt.

Protect from heat and liquids; blot spills immediately.

For general spot cleaning, use a 1:20 ratio of mild soap and cold water. Using a white, lint-free cloth, blot to remove excess water and allow to air dry.

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PERFORMANCE WOOL

Featuring superior seam strength and a cozy, woolen feel, this woven performance upholstery is highly resistant to pilling and stains.

Ideal for families and pet-lovers.

Suitable for heavy-duty commercial use.

100% Polyester

Cleaning Code SW (Solvent & Water)

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Vacuum regularly; use a soft brush to loosen and remove surface dirt.

Protect from heat and liquids; blot spills immediately.

A stain-resistant finish repels dirt and causes liquids to bead up and blot away easily.

For general spot cleaning, use a 1:10 ratio of mild dish soap and water; rinse with fresh water and pat dry with a lint-free cloth. For stubborn stains, we recommend repeating the process with a mild detergent solution.

Basketwoven with complementary colors, this multi-tonal, linen-like performance upholstery is durable and guaranteed to be fade-resistant for up to three years, making it a perfect choice for sunlit, high-traffic rooms. Cleaning Code SW (Solvent & Water)

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Vacuum regularly; use a soft brush to loosen and remove surface dirt. With wear and use, a softened appearance may develop over time. This is an inherent characteristic of the fabric. Excess surface fibers may be removed with a fabric shaver as needed.

Protect from heat and liquids; blot spills immediately.

A stain-repellent finish provides long-lasting protection that endures repeated washings and causes liquids to bead on the surface of the fabric for easy cleaning. For general spot cleaning, blot excess liquids with a soft, clean cloth or sponge. Gently dab the spot to remove the remainder of the stain. For more stubborn stains, apply a natural soap or mild detergent to the cloth and rub gently. Rinse with clean water and allow to air dry.

Chlorine bleach will not affect the coloration of the solution-dyed acrylic fiber and is therefore acceptable for the removal of stubborn stains. Because harsh detergents affect the strength of any fiber, a diluted 1:2 ratio of bleach to water is recommended. Thorough rinsing is essential.

Professional dry cleaning is also recommended for tough stains.

Cleaning Code SW (Solvent & Water)

MAINTENANCE & IN-HOME CARE

Vacuum regularly; use a soft brush to loosen and remove surface dirt.

To remove wrinkling or even the appearance of the pile, apply steam gently – from a distance of at least ½ of an inch – while using a soft-bristled brush in the direction of the nap. Do not apply an iron or steamer directly to the pile or the backing, as it will damage the fabric.

Protect from heat and liquids; blot spills immediately.

A stain-resistant finish repels dirt and causes liquids to bead up and blot away easily.

For general spot cleaning, blot excess liquid from the surface. Using a clean, damp cloth or sponge, gently dab the spot to remove the remainder of the stain. For more stubborn stains, apply a natural soap or mild detergent to the cloth and rub gently. Rinse with clean water and allow to air dry. As a final step, comb the pile with a soft-bristled brush in the direction of the nap.

Chlorine bleach will not affect the coloration of the solution-dyed acrylic fiber and is therefore acceptable for the removal of stubborn stains. Because harsh detergents affect the strength of any fabric, we recommend a diluted 1:2 ratio of bleach and water. Thorough rinsing is essential. Professional dry cleaning is also recommended for tough stains.
