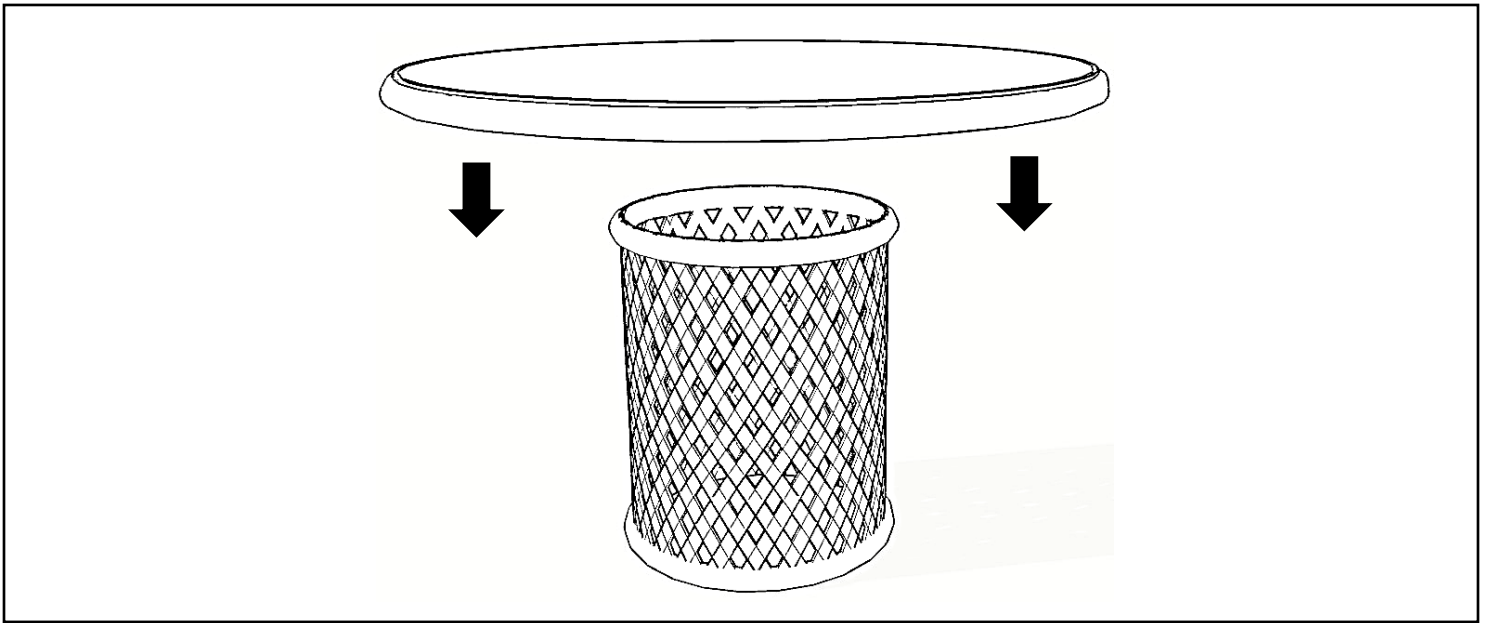
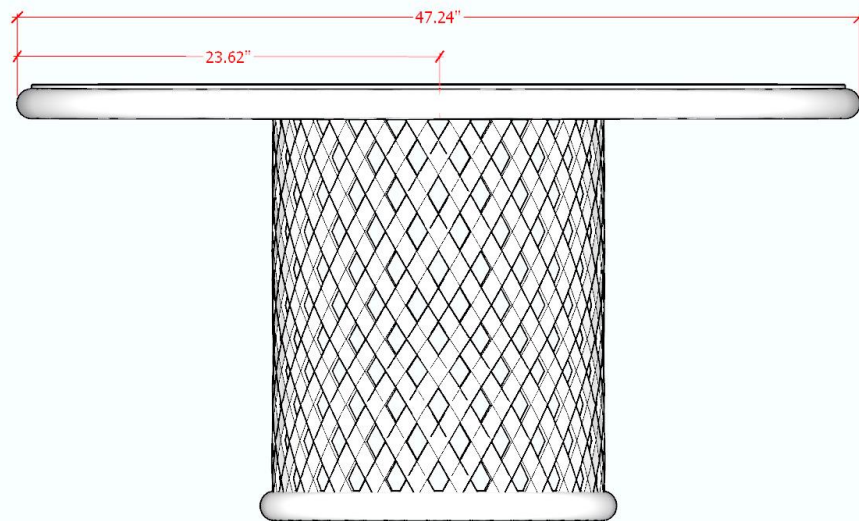




Naples Dining Base w/ 47.24 dia Top



TO ASSEMBLE:

- 1.) Unpack box contents onto a scratch free surface
- 2.) Place base in desired location. Make sure the location is perfectly flat/levelled
- 3.) Follow the proper spacing provided this to ensures the Stability, Safe usage and Eliminates the issues caused by improper placement of the bases.
- 4.) Carefully place top onto base, gently lowering until the top sits firmly onto the base.
- 5.) When fully assembled, check for any movement. If any, adjust or check floor level.

Reconstituted Stone - Care & Maintenance

To ensure your reconstituted stone product will provide you with a lifetime of aesthetics and utility, a proper maintenance program is crucial. Reconstituted Stone products are porous by nature and require a different maintenance program.

Many of the cleaners acceptable for use on ceramic products can stain, damage or dull stone. Therefore, reconstituted stone should be cleaned frequently to remove abrasive agents from its surface. Reconstituted stone should be cleaned with neutral cleaners. Cleaners should never contain acid or bleach. Acids that can damage the natural stone appearance of your purchase product.

Stone Cleaners:

Only use cleaners specifically designed for cleaning natural stone. These cleaners contain no acids and are concentrated neutral pH cleaners that will not affect existing sealers. The surface of the Reconstituted stone should be dampened with clear water. This will keep the cleaning solution from sticking on the surface.

Once the stone has been cleaned, remove excess cleaning solution to prevent staining the surface of the reconstituted stone, do this procedure as often as needed. Care & maintenance should be a routine schedule to maintain the natural stone finish of your purchase product.
